

Put on Your Walking Shoes and Visit: Faneuil Hall, where the citizens of Boston voted their opposition to Tyrants and their Minions; Paul Revere's house, the only seventeenth-century wooden dwelling still standing in any major American city; The Old South Meeting House, where Sam Adams' December 16, 1773 oration led to the Boston Tea Party; The Old State House, the site of Boston's first public reading of the Declaration of Independence

This is a great book on the Freedom Trail located in Boston, MA! It gives a detailed history of each attraction, and even provides some background as to how each one fits into American history, especially the American Revolution. This will make my visit to Boston more enjoyable! My 10 year

old has read it and he finds it fascinating! The book is relatively short at around 175 - 200 pages. The descriptions are short enough to quickly read, but detailed enough to be interesting.

Reading Boston's Freedom Trail before arriving in Boston allowed for a better understanding of the sites along the trail. I carried it with me as we walked the trail and read information about each site to those traveling with me. We all enjoyed the information offered, and it was easy to use. This a must for anyone planning to experience the Freedom Trail!
