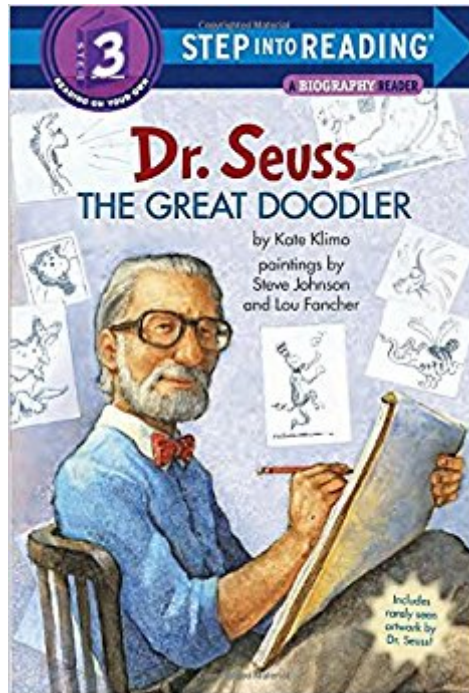

The husband-and-wife team of STEVE JOHNSON and LOU FANCHER has illustrated over thirty books, including "Jim Henson: The Guy Who Played with Puppets" by Kathleen Krull; "The Boy on Fairfield Street," also by Kathleen Krull; "My Many Colored Days" by Dr. Seuss; "New York" by Bravest; "Bravest" by Mary Pope Osborne; and "Amazing Peace" by Maya Angelou. Their book with Lois Duncan, "I Walk at Night," was a "New York Times" Best Illustrated Book. They are also the recipients of a Society of Illustrators Gold Medal.
