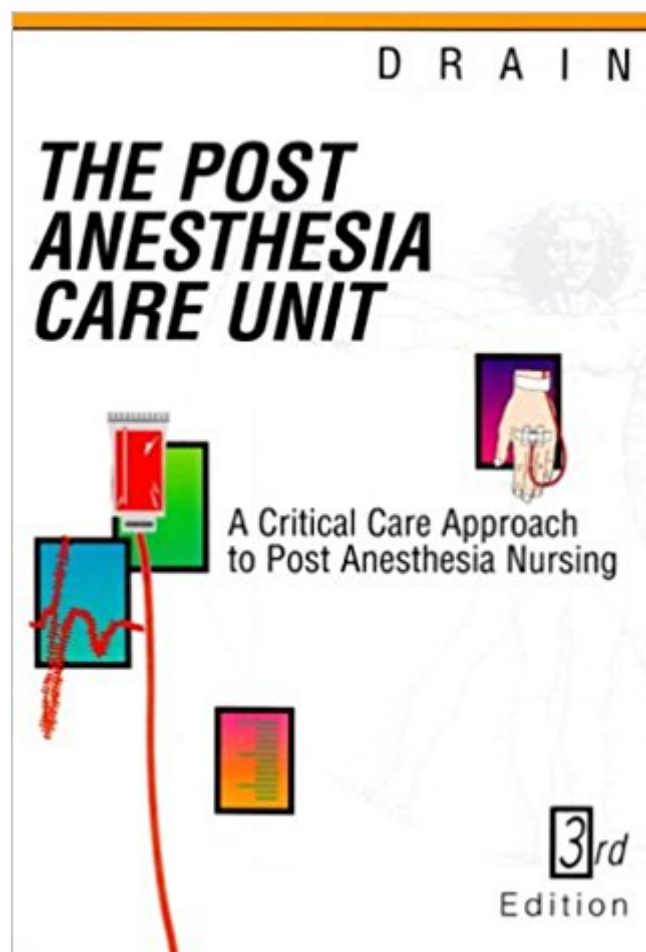


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Post Anesthesia Care Unit: A Critical Care Approach To Post Anesthesia Nursing
