

We just got back from a whirlwind trip to Stockholm and this book was with me every step of the way. Like all the books in this series, it is very detailed with lots of pictures, illustrations and information. I found myself reading it on the plane trip home because the pictures let you re-live the trip. The information in the book was all accurate and up-to-date. My only complaint is that they like everything...I wish they would offer a few more opinions like "Don't miss!" or "If you have time, okay, but not worth a special trip." I did use this book in conjunction with the Lonely Planet guide to Sweden which is much more opinionated. Together, the two books were all I needed for a very successful trip.

I Agree with several reviews ... about DK Eyewitness Travelguides, as a whole serie: It's the most complete, helpful and enjoyable amongst the series i've known. It doesn't mean that each title deserves the 5 stars rating. Despite the insuperable editions covering Spain, Portugal, Great Britain, Japan, Amsterdam, New York, Prague, Istanbul, Tuscany ... There are also editions, like this one (Stockholm), very good, as usual, considering it's a DK Eyewitness Guide (perfect 3D schemes, photos, context info, maps...), but lacking something to be perfect: It doesn't cover any site/town located more than 30 minutes from the capital's centre (ex: the amazing Upsalla), which doesn't happen on the Amsterdam, Brussels and Istanbul editions, for instance. Instead, it covers each lost corner of Stockholm, painting it too much greater than this wonderful place actually is. The result is a book with 30 or something pages more than necessary to help the most exigent traveler. As it comes in the best of papers ... this takes more of our money, puts some "stones" into the traveler handbag and makes the truly useful information diluted there. Perhaps that's the reason for the complaining issued by a previous reviewer: A guide not much opinionated. I would rather say: It's not a matter of opinion. The Lonely Planet and Rough guides sometimes opine "snoby", like intruders, considering us simple-minded, unable to have our own opinions. It's a matter of to bring or not good/essential DATA, INFORMATION and TIPS to the readers. This guide has 224 pages. Comparing it with the 192 pages of the uniquely concise Brussels/Antwerp/Ghent/Bruges edition (in fact, all the Belgium in one edition) the first gives half in change. It's a case of less for more. Anyway, if you plan staying a week in Greater Stockholm only (and the city deserves it), you should take this guide with you. There's no better in the market restricted to your purpose.

This book is wonderful! Aside from excellent descriptions of hotels, shopping and tourist sites, the "street finder" is very useful.

We're planning a trip to Stockholm in Spring 2003. This book is great for those pressed for time, as it gives short overviews of sights in Stockholm, by neighborhood. My only complaint: I wish it had more suggested itineraries. Beautiful pictures and interesting historical perspective throughout, not just in the introduction (as in many guides).

With this guide you can choose what location, monuments, palaces and museums you want to go. It's illustrated with amazing details and helps you to plan your trip and manage your time during the travel.
