

Synopsis

Basic Medical Endocrinology, Fourth Edition provides up-to-date coverage of rapidly unfolding advances in the understanding of hormones involved in regulating most aspects of bodily functions. Topics are approached from the perspective of a physiologist with over 40 years of teaching experience. This fourth edition is richly illustrated in full color with both descriptive schematic diagrams and laboratory findings obtained in clinical studies. Each of the fourteen chapters starts with an overview of the topic and ends with a Suggested Reading list. Initial chapters lay a foundation by presenting basic information and principles of hormone structure, secretion, and actions, and the physiological roles of the principal endocrine glands. Subsequent chapters address the role of the endocrine system in solving such physiological problems as the regulation of the volume and composition of body fluids in the face of changing environmental demands, and the regulation of short- and long-term energy balance. The final chapters deal with the indispensable role of hormones in growth, development and reproduction. Strikes an excellent balance between systems/organismal level of overview and cellular/molecular analysis. Richly illustrated with over 250 full color figures, descriptive schematic diagrams, and laboratory findings. All chapters have been thoroughly rewritten and updated, including new discussions of adrenal steroid biosynthesis, the parathyroid in osteoporosis, obesity and metabolism, as well as an entirely new chapter on gastrointestinal hormones. Editor has 45 years of experience teaching endocrinology and physiology to medical students at Harvard and UMass.

This is a nice text for an undergraduate-level or graduate-level basic Endocrinology class. The book itself is very succinct, compact, and lightweight. Its content is trim and well-organized, and it's filled with colorful, easy-to-understand figures. The writing is lucid, fairly casual, and easy to understand, which I appreciated for a subject that is so dense with information. The book is not extremely indepth. That's okay, though--it's self-described as a "basic" level book. It spares a student the more complicated explanations of many subjects for more advanced texts. For a student unfamiliar with endocrinology in general, this is a great book to introduce the major concepts of the field. I'll be keeping this book for reference in later years of school!

Ok so the book reads ok, not the best piece of literature. What I disliked the most was that molecules are often illustrated wrong. Professors are supposed to read through the book and make sure these mistakes don't make it to the next edition. The frequency with which this occurs is annoying. Its the fourth edition and seems like I purchased the rough draft. Lets just say that who ever drew these structures would not pass an undergraduate organic chemistry course.

This book had torn pages that were taped back together unevenly. The first two pages of the Table of Contents were ripped off.

I'm a first year medical student and this book is one of our required texts for our Endocrinology block. The book is very well written and reads like a novel, two features which I highly value. That said, I bought this book new, and have found that the there are SERIOUS issues in terms of the quality of the end product. By which I mean, every few pages the printing of the text is compromised and appears fuzzy/hazy for an entire page or more. Furthermore, there are numerous grammatical, spacing, and spelling errors. For a textbook, this is simply unacceptable. A mistake here, or there, is understandable, but having fuzzy text on an entire page, and frequently, is simply ridiculous. CONCLUSION: I suggest you stay away from the new edition and perhaps purchase a used older edition. In any case, the new edition is not worth the money - given the gross negligence of the manufacturer.
