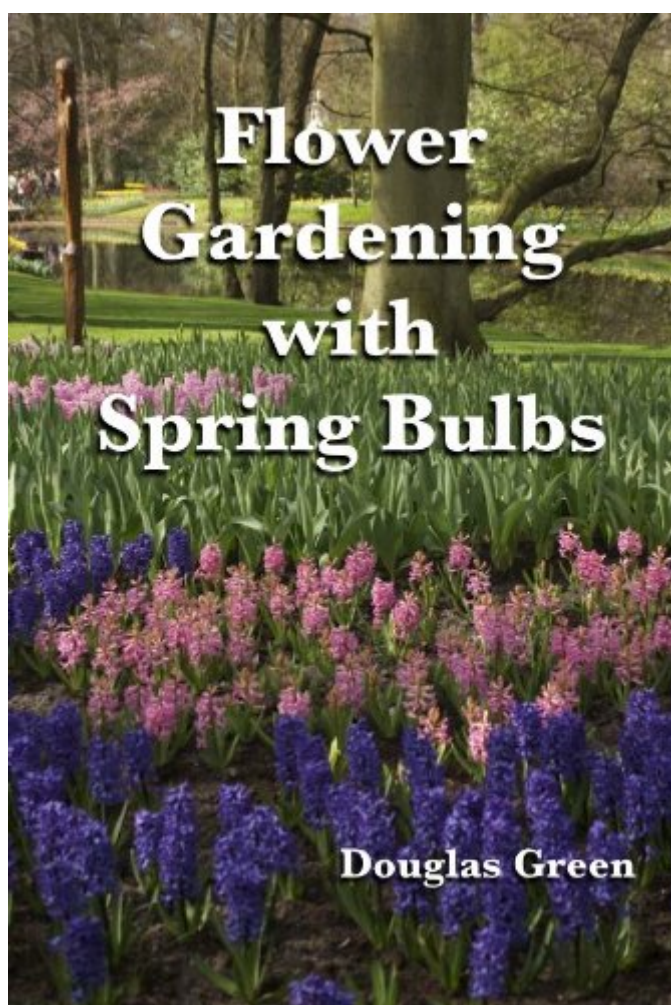

Mr. Green offers practical advice in a friendly manner that comes across as your next door green-thumbbed neighbor that you would love to hate if he wasn't so darned nice! I liked the quick facts and a photo of the flowering bulb. I have the version that suffers from a glitch that causes the

first letter of the first word of captions to appear on the page before the image itself. This is a wonderful handbook with only 1,257 locations, still, a TOC (active preferred) would have been most helpful since he gives information on 19 bulbs. Here are the content locations per kindle3: Tulips (beginning) - Daffodils 321 - Allium or Ornamental Onion 462 - Anemone 527 - Bletilla striata 610 - Chionodoxa or Glory of the Snow 637 - Corydalis solida 663 - Crocus 697 - Eranthis or Winter Aconite 741 - Fritillaria 786 - Galanthus (Snowdrops) 879 - Hyacinth 914 - Hyacinthoides 1037 - Ipheion 1069 - Muscari 1080 - Ornithogalum 1113 - Puschkinia scilloides libanotica 1160 - Scilla 1191 and Ixiolirion 1214.
