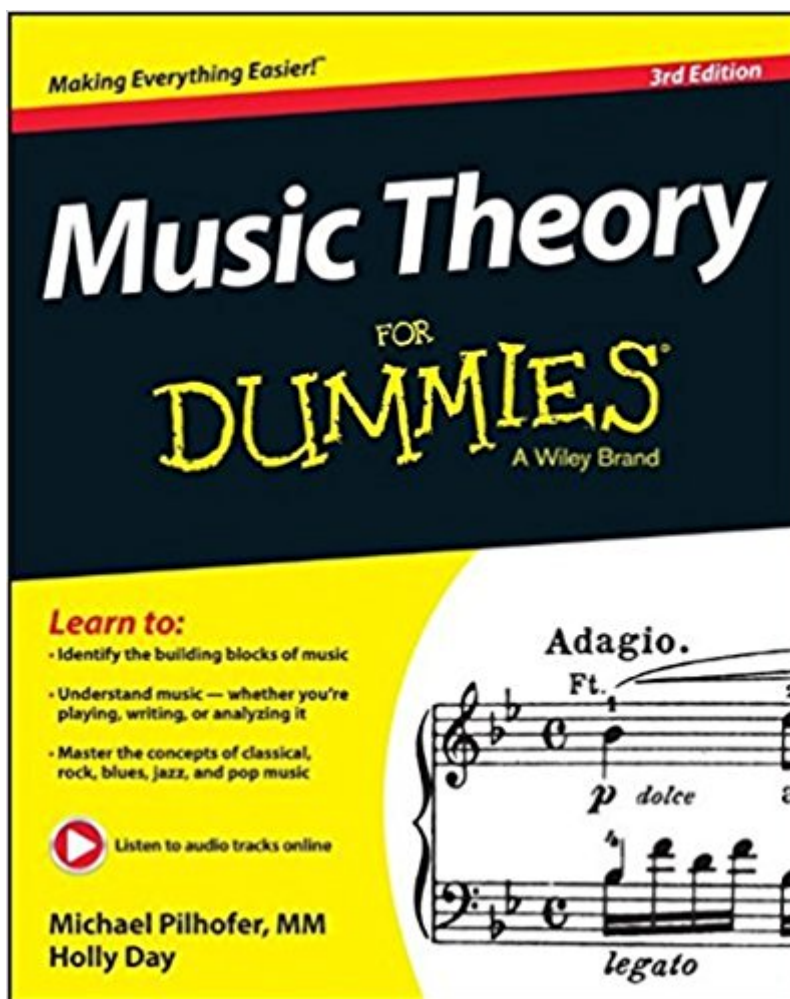

As an amateur musician since age 10, I thought I had a pretty good understanding of music theory. However, as I have been spending more time with my music since retiring, I found some "issues" ... and my previous music theory reference work was long lost to the past. From the very first "for Dummies" books, I have disliked the inherent insult in the title. ... But, past experience with several titles has proved that the "for Dummies" format leads to a reasonably clear discussion of the covered topic's issues. This book provided the clear discussion that both reminded me of "lost" knowledge ... and I even discovered a few things I'd never realized. The construct of "for Dummies"

books delivers a step-by-step approach that builds from first principles to a full understand -- at least in a general level. As such, I would say this is a good book for beginning music students as well as a good review/reference work for the more experienced musician, who as perhaps forgotten past knowledge. Obviously, this is not really a book intended for the advanced musician.
