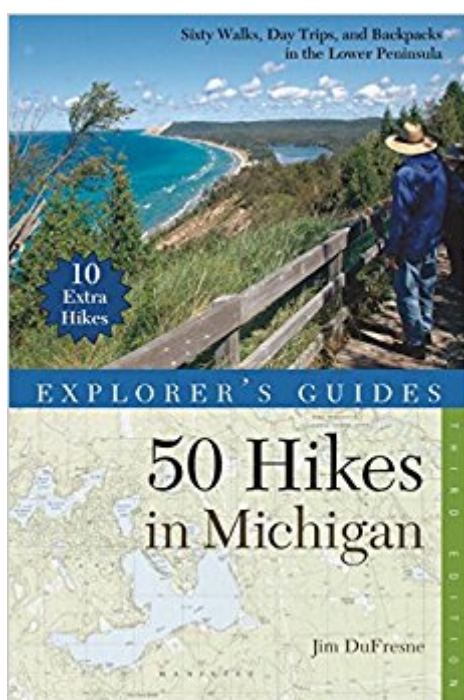

This book delivers! I've been on about 10 of the 60 hikes in the past few months, and without exception I've found the guide to be well detailed, accurate, and generally helpful. For more information, the author also runs a website called "Michigan Trail Maps" that includes even more hiking options. Some of the hikes are a bit short for my taste (I mostly run them so a 1-2 mile hike is over pretty quickly), but one can often combine some of the hikes into longer excursions. This book is highly recommended!
