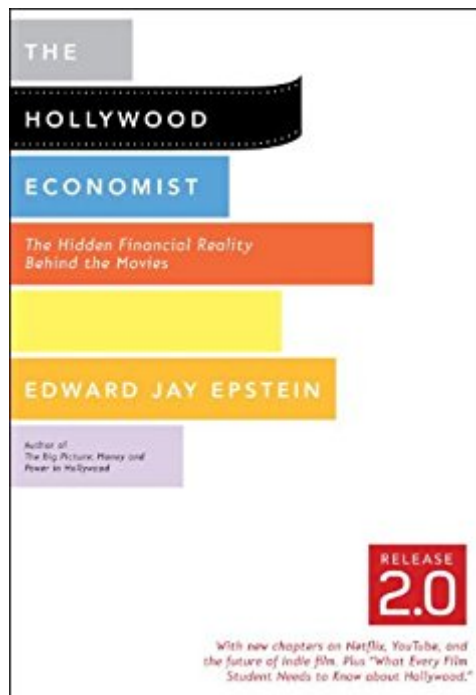


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The Hollywood Economist 2.0: The Hidden Financial Reality Behind The Movies
