

This volume, which is a reprint of Michael Kennedy's edition of the writings of the British composer, is a delight. Vaughan Williams was outspoken, downright, sometimes right, sometimes wrong, but sometimes prophetic. In 1934, Vaughan Williams saw and deplored the commercialism that has grown like a malign vine upon the world of classical music. This book is recommended for anyone who loves Vaughan Williams' music or, for that matter, British music during the last century.
