


The book was found

Stumbled on the Movie before the book and the movie definitely smoothed out areas of the book that were weak and gave it a better if implausible ending. The biggest weakness in the book is the character is superhumanly smart in some things and incredibly dense and stupid in others. The Russian mafia guy was a poor plot device, surely the character could have been patient enough to sock away the money to play the stock market on a larger scale. The antagonist of a back door government program along with deeper detail about the self improvement cult could have been fleshed out better and the mafia dropped altogether.

I thoroughly enjoyed this novel. However, it's worth mentioning that one of the largest distractions is that this character, who happens to be on a smart drug, really makes some very bad decisions. Part of me wants to look for deeper reasons about why this could be, the reality is that doesn't change a thing. Great novel. Great story. Quite engaging. Very hard to put down. On one hand you find yourself reading the story, and on the other hand you find yourself fantasizing about what you might do yourself. Perhaps, this is where the frustration over the novel comes in: it's quite easy to disagree with the actions this main character.

Where as in the book Eddies only real problem is that he is afraid he will run out MDT which he eventually does. Or rather some ominous character comes in and somehow manages to rob him blind because "they've been watching him from the start".
