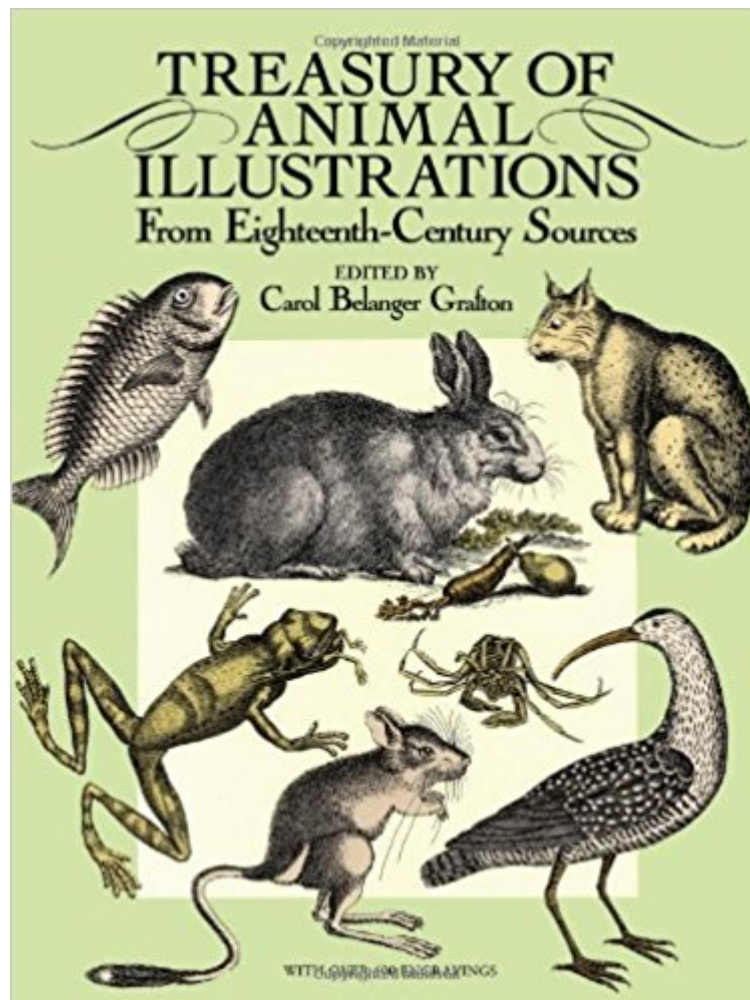




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Treasury Of Animal Illustrations: From Eighteenth-Century Sources (Dover Pictorial Archive)
