

Akira Toriyama's first weekly series, Dr. Slump, has entertained generations of readers in Japan since it was introduced in Shueisha's Weekly Shonen Jump magazine in 1980. A few years later, he created his wildly popular Dragon Ball series, which brought him international success. Toriyama is also known for his character designs for video games, including Dragon Warrior, Chrono Trigger and Toba No. 1. He lives with his family in Japan.

I just read this one again in preparation for what I hope to be a full read of the Dragon Ball manga (all 42 volumes covering the Dragon Ball story as well as Dragon Ball Z) and it's just damn good fun. Dragon Ball is one of those universes like Star Wars, or LotR, that I just wanted to ditch my own life for and be a part of growing up. It's just a fun world. There are dinosaurs, but there are also futuristic capsules that pop out full size houses and motor bikes. There are flying clouds (that you may ride as long as you're pure of heart). There are staffs that can grow to a distance equal to the moon at Goku's whim. There are martial artists who can focus their dormant energy into a physical energy blast obliterating mountains. There are alien species that transform into giant monkey-monsters at the sight of a full moon. And that's just the first two volumes! Call it nostalgia but I love Dragon Ball, and if you can get your hands on the series I think you will too.

The content is five-star Dragon Ball Z. You either like it or not. My critiques for this iteration of the story is that the binding seems to generally give out around the cover material. Nothing's fallen out yet, but it's a blemish on the book's presentation, as well as a bad omen for what future readings could do to its construction. Also, it's displeasing how some of the originally-in-color pages are colored and others are not. . . it just seems fairly arbitrary. I'm specifically talking about the grayscale pages, and not the regular manga black-and-white. Overall, I like that I can purchase three volumes of DBZ for a fraction of the price if I bought separate volumes, but I would have liked better binding, and more color pages (in the case of the pages that were originally in color).
