

Page-turning action as the Ranger tangles with the close-knit families of the Shenandoah valley and finds nothing is tighter than family loyalty, even when members of the family are sadistic killers. Great characters who make the Hatfields and McCoys somewhat tame by comparison. Far more than moonshiners, these are killers without remorse who even find excuses to kill their own children. And they must be stopped. Well worth the time.
