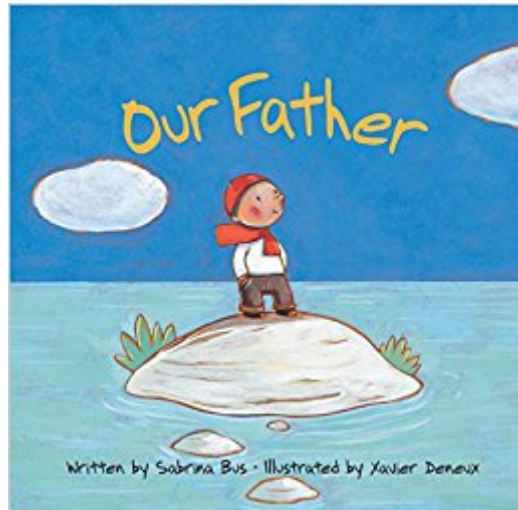

I loved the idea of this book, however, the actual prayer in this book is not the same version that is recited each week in our church. I attend a traditional Catholic Church, and I purchased this book to use to teach my almost 4 year old. I will still use this book, however, I will have to modify it to match

what I need him to learn to recite at church.

Feel terrible giving this book one star, but it does not contain the traditional words to the prayer. I prefer the traditional version and would not have made this purchase otherwise.

The Lord's Prayer itself is accurate enough in the book and the illustrations are nice. However this book misses the mark on several pages in trying to translate the Lord's Prayer to kids. It's easy enough for kids to understand, but it's not a biblically accurate translation of the Lord's prayer according to the Bible. I only saw the first page of the book through the book preview, and page 1 is great! Many other pages just really are not accurate in portraying God's true character.
