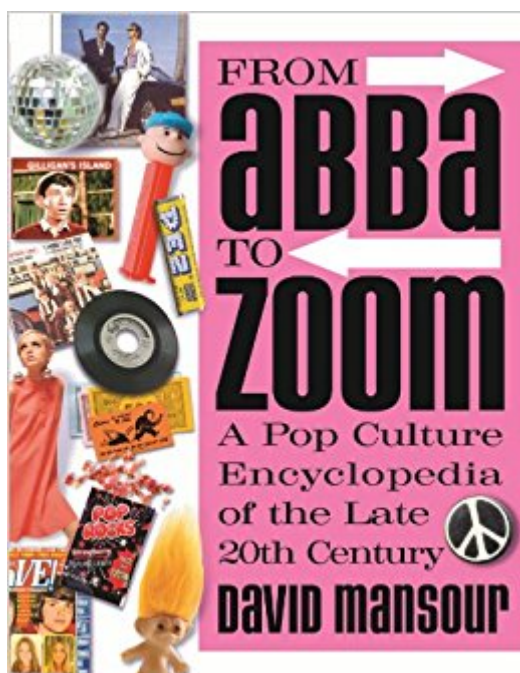


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From Abba To Zoom: A Pop Culture Encyclopedia Of The Late 20th Century
