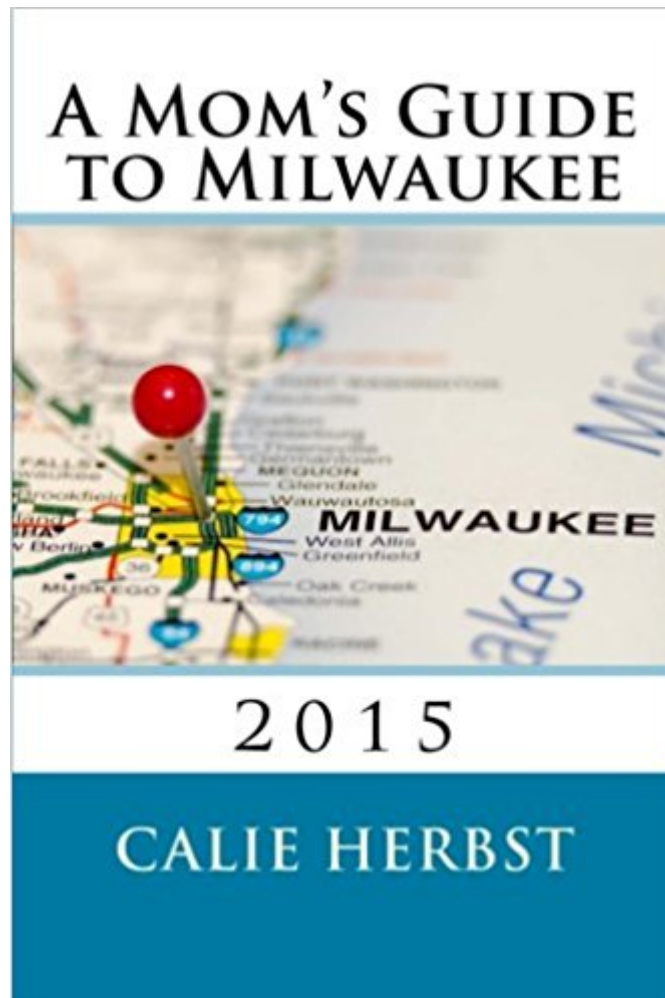




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A Mom's Guide To Milwaukee 2015
