

They list prices wherever possible and have categories from one \$ to \$\$\$\$\$. They list the lowest cost of a double room in high season, and average price of main course at dinner or lunch. Adult admission fees are listedA typical chapter on an area lists top reasons to go, getting oriented, planning with info on festivals, transportation for air, boat, bus, car, train. Then tours, top attractions, where to eat, where to stay, nightlife and performing arts, shopping, side trips with maps and colorful picturesEverything is vetted. There are valuable tips on when to go and ways to save. And there's an insider perspective from local experts. There's a map at the end that is laminated you can pull out. And there's an index to look up information in the almost 700 pages of this guide. There are also maps sprinkled throughout the book on specific areas. This seems like an excellent introduction to travel in New Zealand. It's extremely comprehensive and can keep you reading for a long while as you decide where to go and what to do in New Zealand.
