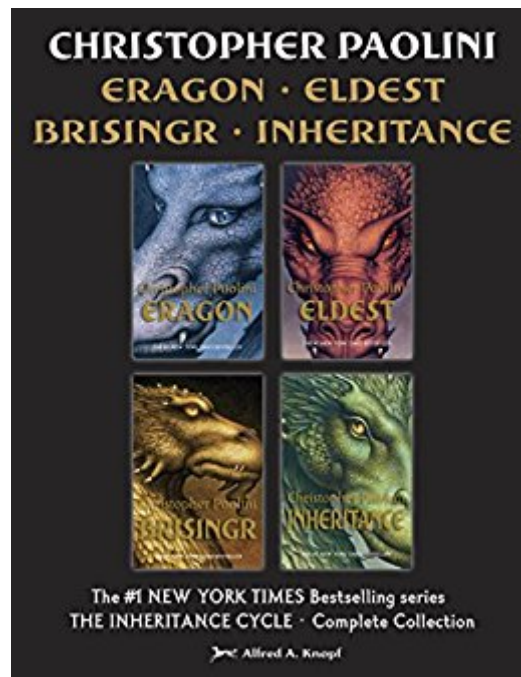




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The Inheritance Cycle Complete Collection: Eragon, Eldest, Brisingr, Inheritance
