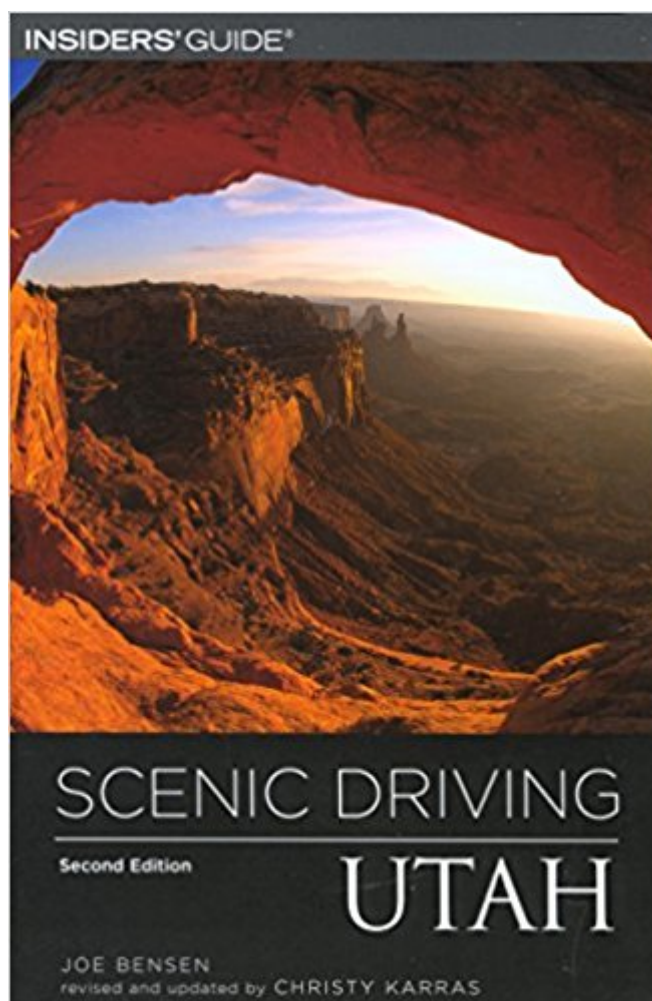

This book is great! Extremely useful with lots of detail about back roads in Utah. Some of the information is now out of date (it's 5 years old after all) but the route descriptions and general flavor of the routes is still quite accurate. Lots of "hidden" stuff to see and do.

I used this book on my recent driving trip to Zion, Bryce, Capitol Reef, Arches and Canyonlands. It was a real highlight on the trip. My friend, who was navigator, used it for "color commentary" on the drive. It's also a great supplement to other guidebooks such as Frommer's and Lonely Planet. My only criticism is that the maps and illustrations would be better in color and the text is a bit verbose. In spite of those bits, it's still five stars.

We just returned from a wonderful motorcycle tour of southern Utah and this book and a map were the only guides we had in the saddlebags. We used Trip Advisor to help decide on lodging options and used this book to explore unusual gravel roads and side trips off the highway. One example, Valley of the Gods, is a side trip we never would have taken but on the advice of the book, we did. It was well worth it. Also loved Rte 12, described as the most scenic road in Utah in this book. It is! Worth every penny. Would have liked to have more mileage info but that's what we had the map for.

Bought this for an upcoming road trip and it was very helpful and informative.
