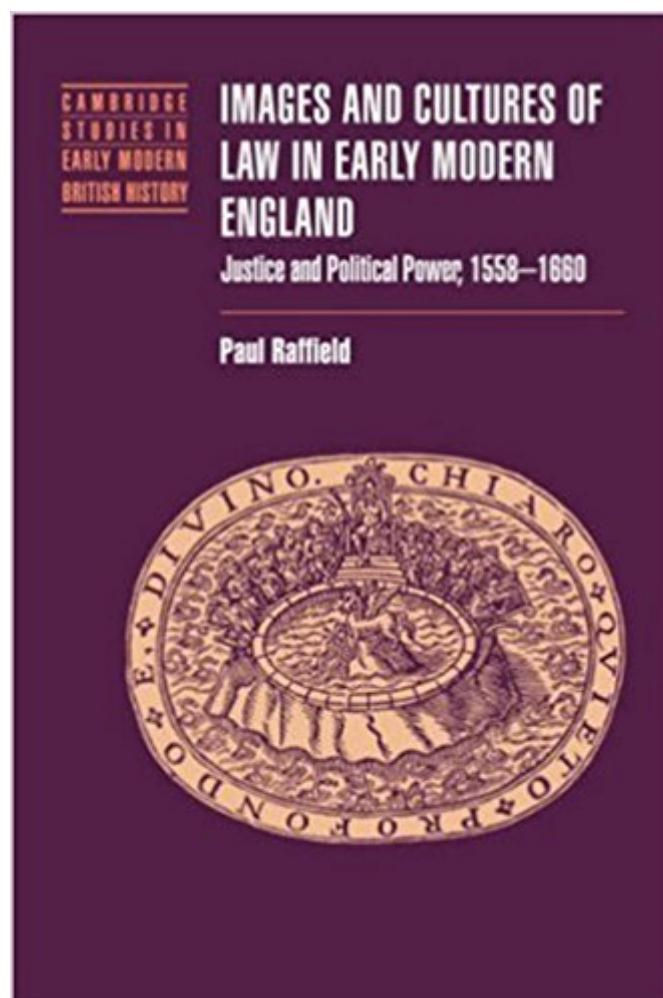


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Images And Cultures Of Law In Early Modern England: Justice And Political Power, 1558-1660 (Cambridge Studies In Early Modern British History)





Synopsis
