

Grade 6-9-This is an update of a title originally published in 2000. The text consists of a history of

epidemics, their causes, the people who worked to control the microbes, and cures, if available. The revisions include a section on anthrax in the discussion of "Great Plagues of History," some updated information on AIDS, and a new chapter on bioterrorism. Friedlander points out that although this is a relatively new term, the practice goes back to ancient cultures. Specific examples are given, from ancient Greece to the present. This is a readable, intriguing overview of the destructive power of epidemics and the critical work of public health professionals. Black-and-white and full-color photographs and reproductions, both contemporary and archival, appear throughout along with numerous depictions of microbes. In this informative and highly readable account that successfully walks a tightrope between information and dramatic embellishment, Friedlander illustrates the drama inherent in outbreaks of disease--and the heroic and often ingenious efforts of the people who try to understand and contain them. The sense of mystery and urgency that accompanies such outbreaks is succinctly conveyed in an introduction describing an actual case in 1940s New York City, in which homeless men with blue-tinged skin began appearing on the streets. In the chapters that follow, Friedlander explains important concepts and terminology, presents an interesting historical overview of epidemiology, and looks at contemporary outbreaks, among them Ebola and Legionnaire's Disease. There's also a frank, responsible chapter on AIDS. The book is nicely designed and illustrated. Especially noteworthy are the richly colored photomicrographs of bacteria, viruses, and cells.
