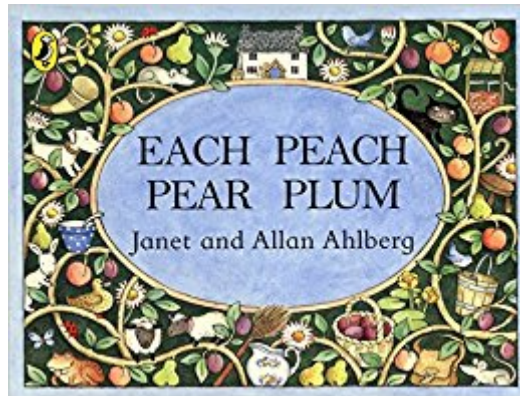

Janet & Allan Ahlberg created many acclaimed picture books from 1975 to shortly before Janet's death in 1994. Allan taught before becoming a full-time writer and Janet studied graphic design before becoming an illustrator. EACH PEACH PEAR PLUM and THE JOLLY CHRISTMAS POSTMAN won Kate Greenaway Medals and PEEPO! won Parents Magazine's Best Books For Babies Award.

Originally published in 1979, this is one of those books that sat in our library until we had children old enough to enjoy it. Our son thought it was ok but our daughter really loved it. So much so that when I forgot to pack it to read on the bus to school one day I had a problem. Fortunately, the Kindle version of the book is very well done with the pages set side by side so that I can read them to my daughter and she can look at the pictures while I am reading. The illustrations are large enough (and my daughter knew the story well enough) that she can still find the 'I Spy' portion of the book while on my phone. With my older eyes, I prefer the tablet but both versions are still quite good.

This book is an utter delight. I had never heard of it before recommended it, but my kids are obsessed. My seven-year-old son has memorized it and sings it to the little kids, who often ask to have it read to them. I really like the way there is something for the kids to find/do with each page,

but just one thing. We keep moving, but they are engaged. I also felt like all of the drawings were charming and memorable. This will be a new go-to gift for new parents.

I had forgotten how fun this book is! The rhyming is wonderful, but the illustrations are what make it so wonderful. It is truly a seek and find kind of book, where you find new little details nearly every time it is read. For this reason, it is one of those books that will grow with the child for many years to come.
