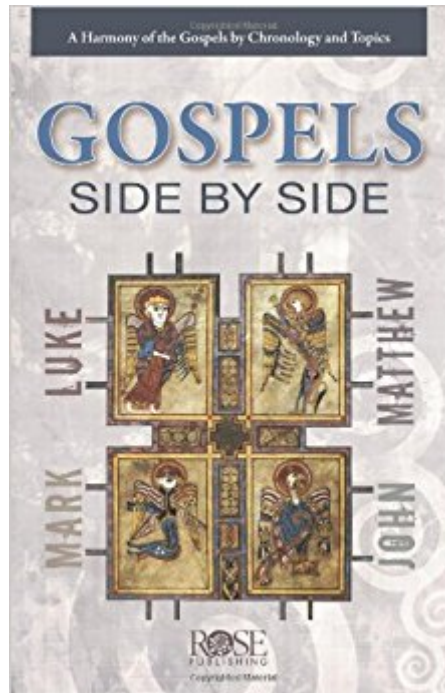

This pamphlet lays out the four gospels and their events in an easy to understand format. The four gospels each tell Jesus's story from its own point of view. A story may be found in all of the gospels, while another story may only be found in just one of the gospels. The charts lay it all out for you. There is a chart for all the events, one for miracles, one for the parables, and another for all the places he visited. The chart works by listing the event and where it can be found in Matthew, Mark, Luke or John by scripture reference. The pamphlet has a section that also gives you an overview on the gospels themselves, what viewpoint they were written from, and who the audience was that the author was writing to. There is also a map of Israel during Jesus' time that depicts what cities existed at the time and which are still present today. This pamphlet is very visually engaging and would be very helpful to have handy in a Bible class or in your own personal study.

I love reading. But hands-down, without a doubt, my favorite book to read is the Bible. So I'm always intrigued by any resource that can help me get more out of my time in the Scriptures. In "The Gospels Side-By-Side" by Rose Publishing, I found a goldmine. This short pamphlet is chockfull of graphics, charts, maps and historical background information that helped me see the bigger picture of the story of Jesus that the Gospel writers were conveying to us. It begins with the unique perspective of each Gospel writer, and launches us deeper into the Bible from there. In this book you will see things like: * The events of Christ's life, and which Gospel tells particular events * The miracles of Jesus * The parables of Jesus * The chronological movements of Jesus * How Jesus celebrated Passovers during His public ministry * How these biblical biographies compare to other biographies of the era * Even the historical harmony of the Gospel message in the post-apostolic age This should bring new life to any Bible student's reading time! I highly recommend you check out not only this pamphlet, but many of the other resources available at Rose Publishing.

I've always believed in the Bible, but there have been too many times when my faith was shaken by books, commentators, even scholars who took notice of what I called trivialities and expanded on them. I know from life that if 4 witnesses come forward, I'll hear 2 - 4 variances on what occurred. They meant all saw the event from different vantage points. None are wrong, they saw what they saw. So the gospels were written sometimes based on what the author saw or was told. Mark was either a son or close follower of Peter, he apparently was better educated than a fisherman, so he wrote what he heard Peter say. All of our memories erode or vary in time. None of the gospels were written immediately after Christ's appearance. There was a great deal more that happened, than was told writing materials had a cost and were not always available. Bottom line was we are told what we need to hear. The differences add depth to me. Like a movie we see the same scene

from different angles and characters. I do believe, and follow Jesus. I see no problems with slightly different angle views. Read for yourself, you'll be glad you did.

This book was well packaged and shipped within the specified dates. It wasn't exactly what I was looking for, however, it contains much info. about the gospels, that help broaden my personal outlook. I would recommend this book if you are interested in learning more about how the gospels are different and possibly why. I would buy from this seller again as they are dependable and accurate.
