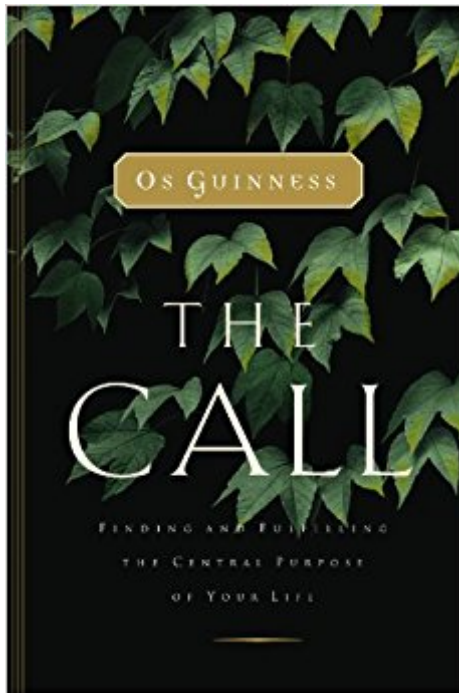

A graduate of the University of London and Oxford, Guinness is a former visiting fellow of the Brookings Institution. He has written or edited more than twenty books, including *The Call*, *Invitation to the Classics*, and *Long Journey Home*. A frequent speaker and seminar leader at political and business conferences in the United States, Europe, and Asia, Guinness has lectured at many universities, including Oxford, Cambridge, Harvard, and Stanford, and has often spoken on Capitol Hill.

Os gets to the meat and heart of this vital topic with insight, clarity and biblical honesty. He does so with the aid of a great many stories and quotes to help us see the whole picture.
