A very solid and creative novel that was a fun read. I really like the author's writing style, and hope that there will be more to come in the series. Took a chance on this one and it was worth it. I'd highly recommend.

The Arthurian legend is vividly reimagined, beginning with a 17-year-old boy awaiting his destiny to rule as his people face multiple threats - from invade Saxons, from internecine warfare, political intrigue and dragons! Myth and magic are woven through the story, which moves as often breakneck speed, introducing us to characters so passionate, conflicted and complex that they jump off the page and beg us to follow them. It's a rollicking adventure, a thoughtful character piece and a great tribute to the Round Table legends that have gone before. Gillman knows his stuff, and he'll have you turning the pages with breathless anticipation. Lancelot, Sir Percival, Guinevere, and of course Merlin - they're all here, brought thrillingly to life by the author's skillful use of language, eye for detail and insight into the human condition. It's smart writing but more than that, it's just plain fun. A great read!

So, this is not my usual genre for a book - but a friend recommended it to me and I couldn't be happier that he did. Full disclosure - I'm not finished with it yet but I've loved what I've read so far: great characters, cool set setting, love the way the characters talk. Usually action scenes in these kind of books start to bore and confuse me a bit, but Gillman somehow makes the action easy follow without losing the tension. They're actually...exciting. Also - I just like the WAY this author writes, it's funny in places, well-paced, and paints great pictures. One of my favorite examples, "His black hair and beard a mess of grease and madness."Omg!
