The illustrations were wonderful and kept the kids' attention. This book encouraged discussion about things that make us scared, but if we try things it may not be as scary as we thought. I highly recommend for young readers. It's also great for beginner readers.

I have read this with 1 and 2 grade children. They loved the story and that it is okay to be scared

because sometimes it is fun to be scared. They talked about times they were scared so it opened a dialogue. I love this series and would recommend all of the books even for kids as young as 4 years old.

We must own three or four of these books now. My three year old daughter loves them. She calls this one the hugging book, see the cover. I like it because I can read it cover to cover in just a few minutes. The story is good enough, clear, and the artwork is not at all bad. I'm not sure about the list of items to be scared of, some are not exactly scary, others might be. Still, this is a great book, and a good series for little ones.

I expected this book to be about thunder or storms or something. I was so excited to see it's about being FUN scared and HAPPY scared! I'm sharing it with my adult kids!!

My 3yo loves this book. He laughs and loves the snake. Entertaining for moms, too. Good message -- Maybe trying things, like roller coasters, that are scary will turn out to be fun. Trying them with a friend is even better. The art is lovely. Will be looking for more of these.
