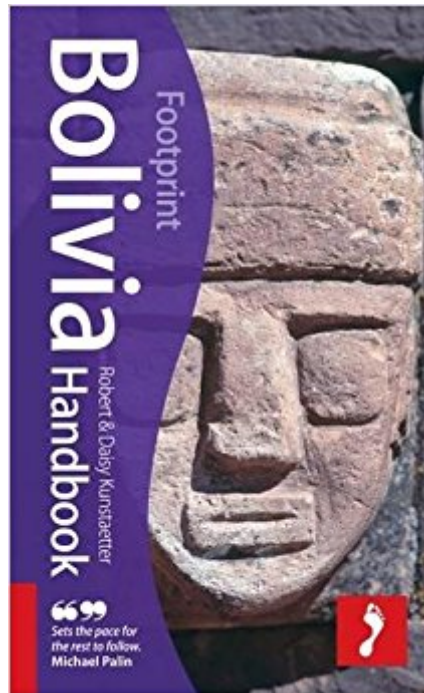




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Bolivia, 5th: Tread Your Own Path (Footprint Bolivia Handbook)
